<b>Re: Rescue and Rehabilitation Supplemental Questions</b>	

Kelly, further to our conversation yesterday, following are the supplemental questions we need answered to determine if this risk is eligible for coverage:

Do the owners of first time rescue horses willingly turn them over to the insured, or are some confiscated against the owners wishes, with or without the assistance of law enforcement?

Do any of the horses come directly from the race track?

Does the applicant have possession of all horses or are some kept at foster facilities?

Assuming all suitable rescue horses are available for sale, is the sale final, or does the applicant retain legal ownership?

Does the adoption contract grant the applicant the right to take a horse back if they determine the owner/adopter is not complying with the terms of the agreement? If so, how do the procedures differ from those described in the answer to the first question?

Please send us copies of all documents and contracts related to the rescue and rehabilitation activities.

These questions can be answered directly on this fax and submitted as a narrative to supplement the application.
